I have 7 years of counseling experience, serving many different populations. I have provided intensive in-home services with children and families, as well as helped individuals improve life skills through mental health skill building. I have worked with acute mentally ill in a psychiatric hospital. I am most experienced in working with adults in crises for mental health and substance use. I have over 2 years' experience of providing individual outpatient therapy, as well as experience in providing couples and marital therapy. I primarily use the theoretical approach of Cognitive Behavioral Therapy; however, I will often use techniques from Motivational Interviewing, Dialectical Behavioral Therapy, Solution-Focused Therapy, Narrative Therapy, and Person-Centered Therapy. Specific techniques include the Miracle Question, Identifying Automatic Negative thoughts, Cognitive Restructuring, Mindfulness, Cognitive Distortions, "Changing the Narrative", as well as implementing Acu Detox.
